Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goal for FY 2018 – 2020

The Nashville-Metropolitan Transit Authority (Nashville MTA) hereby announces the revision of its Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) Program under guidelines of 49 CFR Part 26 and the regulations and direction of the U. S. Department of Transportation (DOT). Nashville MTA announces the establishment of the FY 2018 – 2020 DBE goal of 6.00% for the procurement of goods and services utilizing any DOT funds. This goal has been set based on the information currently available. The rationale for this goal and supporting information regarding Nashville MTA's DBE program will be available for the public inspection at the Nashville Metropolitan Transit Authority, headquarters located at 430 Myatt Drive, Nashville, TN 37115. These documents are available for inspection between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday – Friday for thirty (30) days following the publication of this notice. Nashville MTA and the U. S. DOT will accept comments on the Nashville MTA's DBE Goal and Nashville MTA's DBE Program for forty five (45) days from the date of this notice.
