



Public hearings scheduled for July 26, 27 and 28

The Nashville Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) will hold five public hearings on July 26, 27 and 28 on proposed service adjustments for this fall. Service improvement to five routes will be discussed as well as expanding the Music City Circuit, making BusLink in Madison a fixed route, and establishing a new route near Cane Ridge High School. Proposed modifications to the following routes will be discussed:

20 – Scott

23 – Dickerson Road

26 – Gallatin Road

34 – Opry Mills Local

56 – Gallatin Road BRT

Madison BusLink
