## **MTA buses operating on snow routes through noon on Tuesday**

**NASHVILLE** – Due to winter weather, Nashville MTA buses will continue to operate on snow routes through noon on Tuesday, February 2, 2010. A decision will be made at that time as to whether the buses will remain on snow routes or return to regular routes.

The inclement weather could delay buses due to poor driving conditions and traffic congestion. Safety is MTA's top concern, and the drivers are proceeding cautiously.

In addition, passengers can check the electronic signs at Music City Central, which is located at 400 Charlotte Avenue between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenues North.
