



SPRING 2012 SUMMARY OF CHANGES

The Nashville Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) makes its biannual improvements and adjustments to its transportation network as new schedules go into effect on April 1.

Weekday service on two new lines – **Route 27 Old Hickory** and **Route 36X Madison Express** – has been delayed until Monday, April 30 due to ongoing construction at the MTA facility on Myatt Drive.

The following information includes service changes **effective Sunday, April 1**. Please check the new route schedules for more complete route information since this is only a summary of the spring changes. The new schedules are available online and in the displays at Music City Central.

4 SHELBY

- The night and weekend routing has changed. Buses traveling to downtown will continue on Scott to Greenwood, turn right on Greenwood and turn left on Chapel to the current route.
- Times have been adjusted on all schedules.

7 HILLSBORO

- Times have been adjusted on numerous Saturday and Sunday/Holiday trips.

10 CHARLOTTE

- The Saturday bus departing Walmart at 7:07 a.m. departs nine minutes earlier at 6:58 a.m., stops at Charlotte and Annex at 7:05 a.m., Premier and American at 7:09 a.m., Charlotte and 46th at 7:16 a.m., 20th and Church at 7:25 a.m. and arrives downtown at 7:35 a.m.

15 MURFREESBORO ROAD

- More weekday service to Pearl-Cohn Entertainment Magnet High School has been added.
- The weekday bus departing Tennessee and 51st at 6:24 a.m. departs three minutes earlier at 6:21 a.m., stops at 44th and Albion at 6:25 a.m., Pearl-Cohn Entertainment Magnet High School at 6:37 a.m., Metro General Hospital at 6:42 a.m. and arrives downtown at 6:55 a.m.
- The weekday bus departing Tennessee and 51st at 2:13 p.m. departs three minutes earlier at 2:10 p.m., stops at 44th and Albion at 2:13 p.m., Pearl-Cohn Entertainment Magnet High School at 2:25 p.m., Metro General Hospital at 2:30 p.m. and arrives downtown at 2:42 p.m.
- The bus departing Tennessee and 51st at 2:49 p.m. no longer serves Pearl-Cohn Entertainment Magnet High School.
- The weekday bus departing Music City Central at 6:35 a.m. will continue to serve Pearl-Cohn Entertainment Magnet High School.
- The weekday bus departing Music City Central at 2:15 p.m. stops at Metro General Hospital at 2:25 p.m., Pearl-Cohn Entertainment Magnet High School at 2:29 p.m., 44th and Albion at 2:42 p.m. and arrives at Tennessee and 51st at 2:44 p.m.

20 SCOTT

- The routing has changed to provide service to Bailey STEM Magnet Middle.
- Buses traveling from downtown on Chapel will turn right on Greenwood and left on Scott to the current route. Buses traveling to downtown will continue on Scott to Greenwood, turn right on Greenwood and turn left on Chapel to the current route.

27 OLD HICKORY

(NEW SERVICE effective April 30)

- Buses for this route provide service in Old Hickory via Lakewood.
- Stops include Old Hickory Towers, The Hermitage and Hermitage Station.
- New park-n-rides are located at the former City Hall in Lakewood and at the new MTA Administrative Offices on Myatt Drive in Madison.
- Buses for this route depart from Music City Central Bay 6.
- A Spanish version also is available for this route.

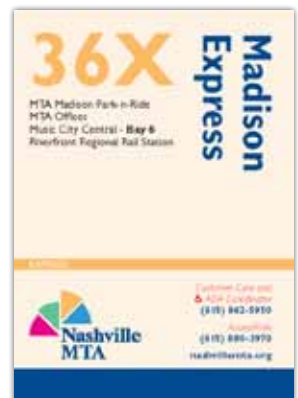

- Buses for this route depart from Music City Central Bay 6.
- A Spanish version also is available for this route.

91X FRANKLIN/BRENTWOOD EXPRESS

- The bus departing 21st and West End at 3:45 p.m. now leaves four minutes later at 3:49 p.m., stops at 21st & Children's Way at 3:57 p.m. before arriving at Music City Central. This bus departs Music City Central at 4:20 p.m., stops at Brentwood Civitan Ball Park at 4:50 p.m. and arrives at the Williamson Square Kroger at 5:09 p.m.
- The bus departing 21st and West End at 4:15 p.m. now leaves seven minutes later at 4:22 p.m., stops at 21st and Children's Way at 4:30 p.m. before arriving at Music City Central. This bus departs Music City Central at 4:55 p.m., stops at 5:26 p.m. and arrives at the Williamson Square Kroger at 5:45 p.m.
