Public meetings scheduled for January 27, 29 and February 3, 5

NASHVILLE – The Nashville Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) and Regional Transportation Authority of Middle Tennessee (RTA) will hold five public meetings on Jan. 27, Jan. 29, Feb. 3 and Feb. 5 regarding proposed improvements for its biannual system changes, including a new BRT lite service for Charlotte Avenue.

Adjustments are being proposed for routes 6 Lebanon Pike, 8 8th Avenue South, 9 MetroCenter, 12 Nolensville Pike, 17 12th Avenue South, 20 Scott, 37X Tusculum/McMurray Express and 42 St. Cecilia/Cumberland.

The RTA will present proposed improvements and adjustments for routes 84X Murfreesboro Express, 86X Smyrna/La Vergne Express and 96X Nashville/Murfreesboro Relax and Ride, including the relocation of the La Vergne Park & Ride lot, as well as possible restructuring of routes 91X Franklin/Brentwood Express and 95X Spring Hill Express.
