MTA to suspend bus service at 9:15 p.m. due to icy road conditions

NASHVILLE – Due to icy road conditions, service on Nashville MTA buses will be suspended at 9:15 p.m. today; however, service will continue through to the end of each route. Customers depending on MTA for a ride home should plan to leave the city before this time. The Music City Star Friday evening train will operate as scheduled.

A decision will be made Saturday as to when the buses will return to service. Customers should anticipate a later start time for service and for buses to be operating on snow route detours when service resumes.

Safety is our number one priority, so please be aware that there may be additional delays as bus operators are proceeding cautiously. We ask that you allow for additional travel time so we can help get you where you need to go safely.
