Music City Star to run regular service this morning

NASHVILLE – This morning, track inspectors determined the railroad tracks for the Music City Star to be free from flooding and cleared the commuter train to operate as regularly scheduled.

The Regional Transportation Authority advised train customers yesterday to prepare themselves for a potential service disruption, should weather conditions lead to flooding along the tracks.
