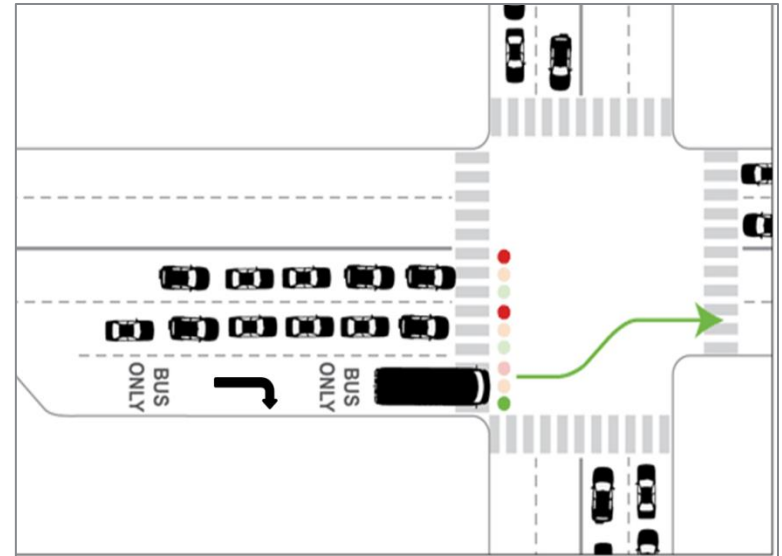


# Understanding a Queue Jump

A queue jump is managed using a combination of a special lane and a transit signal.

- The image to the right shows a right turn/bus lane queue jump situation. A bus moves into this lane approaching an intersection to bypass traffic.
- As the bus approaches the intersection in this lane, the transit signal indicates how the bus is to proceed with geometric shapes.
  - **Transit Signal Indications:**
    - » Go
    - » Slow Down
    - » Stop
- Using the combination of a special lane and transit signal, buses are allowed to efficiently traverse intersections.
